



2008 PREK & EARLY CHILDHOOD PHYSICAL & IMMUNIZATION REQUIREMENTS

HEALTH EXAMINATION: *2 SIDED EXAM FORM* (requires parent and physician completion)
The examination shall be conducted within one year prior to the date of entrance into PreK or Early Childhood. **Lead screening** is a requirement that must be documented by the health care provider by indication on the physical form or attaching an IDPH lead risk assessment questionnaire.

IMMUNIZATIONS:

DPT (diphtheria, pertussis, tetanus) – required to have four or more doses at the required intervals.

POLIO – required to have three or more doses at the required intervals.

MEASLES – required to have one dose at 12 months of age or older.

MUMPS – required to have one dose at 12 months of age or older.

RUBELLA – required to have one dose at 12 months of age or older.

VARICELLA (chicken pox) – required to have one dose on or after 12 months of age or show proof of having the chicken pox illness or provide laboratory evidence of varicella immunity.

HIB (Haemophilus influenzae type b) – required to have one dose on or after 15 months of age or compliance with the IDPH vaccination schedule.

HEPATITIS B – required to have three doses at the required intervals.
